Our feline intakes were dramatically affected by a minor (4 cases) ringworm outbreak. One of these cases occurred in our community room, 2 in kittens, and one isolated in a solo environment. This shut down our community room for adoption that contained 7 cats and prevented us from taking in more felines due to space constraints and quarantine protocols.
